They're carp pooling! Two little brothers splash about with fish that are nearly as big as they are.

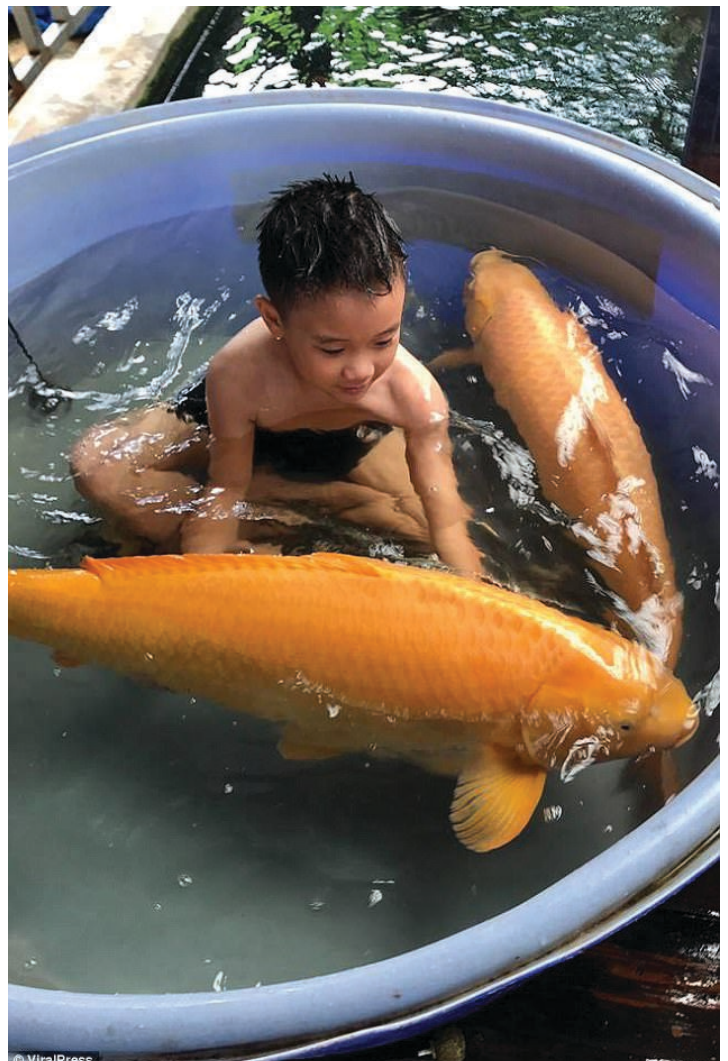


Fish breeder Worawut Chunkum, 42, put the ornamental fish in plastic blue tubs for their mid-year health check up on July 9. His sons Taechin, 8, and Nischin, 4, climbed into the temporary homes with the fish, splashing around with them in Nan, Thailand.

The clip shows the fish, who are almost the same size as the boys, swimming by them in the tubs. Taechin posed for a photo holding a carp and with his front facing the water to give viewers a more accurate size difference between him and the colourful fish.

Worawut, who shows the fish in competitions, said: 'It looks like we will need to buy bigger bowls in the future to put the carp in. 'The boys love sitting in the water and playing with the fish. It's their favourite time of the year. 'We check the carp for size, weight and general health. Taechin and Nischin like to join in. The fish are nearly as big as them.'

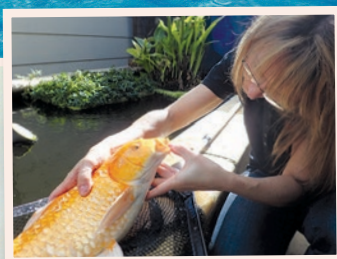

Any club member is free to advertise any business they like, it doesn't have to be koi or pond related, subject to committee approval.

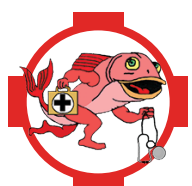

It was announced that Dave Brown had won a cash prize for participating in the KHV survey.

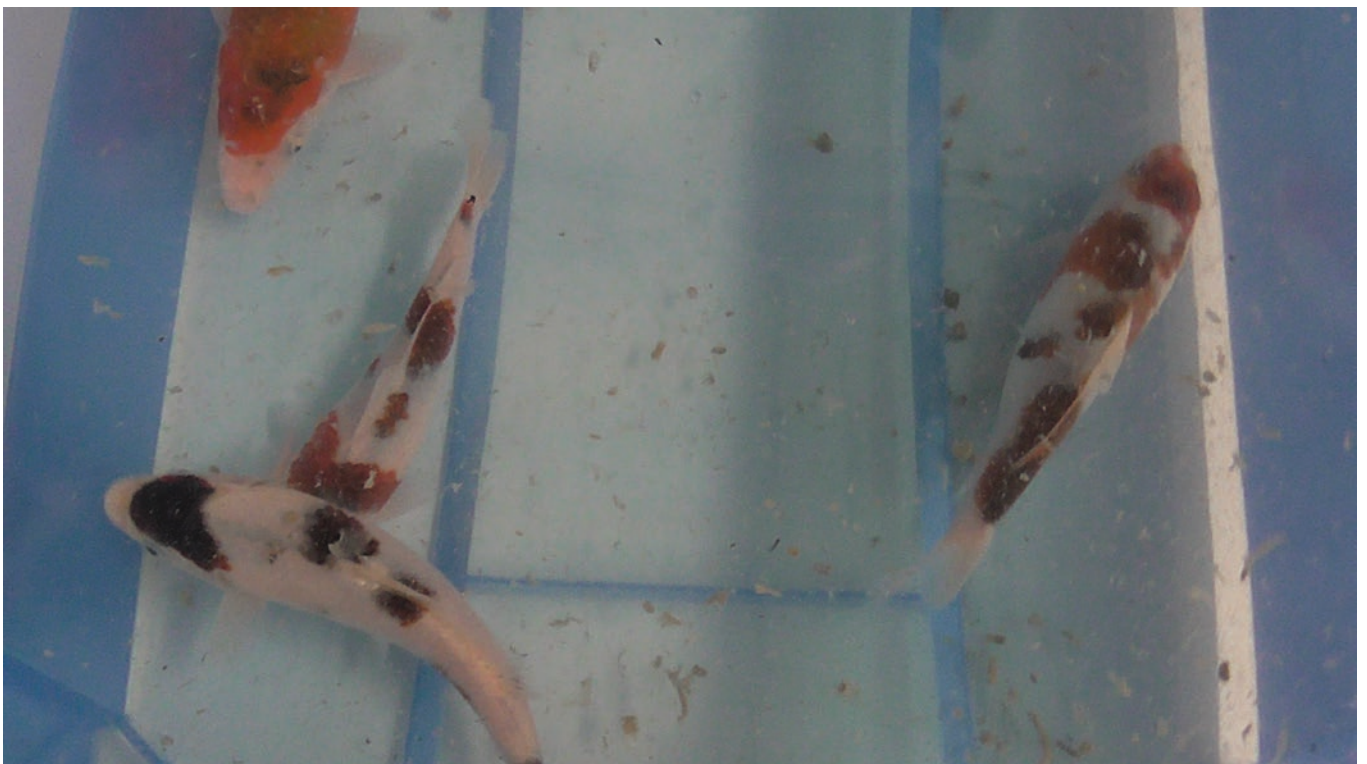
The Raffle won by Dave B and Tony H
