- order in which lots will be auctioned will be strictly in line with order in which bin (s) are booked.
- All pond fish under 25cms to be bagged and price the seller wishes to sell for marked on the bag. Due to time constraints these fish will not be auctioned. Quality fish under 25cm maybe auctioned.
- a request to restrict members lots for auction to APPROXIMATELY 25 LOTS MAX.
- normal fee of 10% sellers and 5% buyers will apply to all sales
- each member to supply their own catching net. Bags, oxygen etc supplied by the KSWA.
- normal separation/quarantine measures will be applied where practicable.
