TATEGOI - What to look for in a young Koi. What are the indicators to suggest that a Koi can be expected to improve - to your joy and profit rather than decline to your dismay, leaving a hole in the bottom of both your heart and pocket?

Rod Strang is going to bring in a number of varieties of baby Koi from both his last years Gin Rin Showa spawn and his Sanke spawn from 4 weeks ago, for the members to assess with the guidance and explanations from senior members, to determine which Koi should be expected to improve (Tategoi) and which shouldn't be (Tateshta).

Tateshta are simply Koi that have reached the limit of their potential and who's quality is likely to decline as they age.

The discussion is encouraged to be forthright without the usual polite response to the question -"What do you think of my fish?"

Members from the Northern Branch are as always very welcome and encouraged to attend the South Perth meeting to fast track their knowledge of this not always mysterious subject.
